SECTION III: MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

2. <u>Documents in support of Minimum Eligibility Criteria</u>:

SECTION-IV: BIDS

1. Preparation of Bids:

Two-bid system will be followed for this tender. In this system, bidder must submit his offer as explained below.

- (i) Duly filled Technical Bid with proper seal and signature of authorized person on each page of the bid should be submitted.
- (ii) All the necessary documents including those in support of Minimum Eligibility Criteria should be submitted with Technical Bid. These documents should be self attested.

b. Envelope 2: "Financial Bid"

- (ii) No other documents except %Brice Schedule+may be submitted along with Financial Bid otherwise the bid shall stand rejected.
- (iii) All amounts are to be quoted only in **Bangladeshi Taka**. The price quoted shall be considered firm and no price escalation will be permitted. The prices quoted should be inclusive of charges for freight, insurance, packing, distribution, after sales service, etc.

2. Submission of Bids:

The bid complete in all respect may be submitted to the Head of Chancery, High Commission of India, 1-3 Park Road, Baridhara, Dhaka-1212, Bangladesh. <u>The bids viz.</u> <u>Technical and Financial Bids should be submitted in two sets – one original and one copy</u>.

3. Deadline for Submission of Bids:

- (a) Bids must be submitted on or before **18.09.2019** at **1700** hrs which is the last date for submission of bids.
- (b) In the event of the specified date for the submission of bids being declared a holiday for the High Commission of India, Dhaka and the deadline for submission of bids will stand extended to the next working day up to the same time.
- (c) The High Commission of India, Dhaka may extend the deadline for submission of bids by amending the bid document and the same shall be notified on the website of the High Commission of India, Dhaka.
- (d) No bid (s) will be accepted after the deadline for submission of the bids.

4. <u>Validity of Bids</u>:

- a. Bids shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of 180 days from the last date of submission of bids.
- b. A bid valid for a shorter period shall stand rejected.
- c. The High Commission of India, Dhaka may ask for extension of validity of bids for another

period of 60 days, without any modifications and without giving any reasons thereof. Such request and the response shall be made in writing only.

d. In case, the High Commission of India, Dhaka calls the bidder for negotiation then this shall not amount to cancellation or withdrawal of original offer which shall be binding on the bidder.

5 Bid Opening Procedure:

- a. **Technical Bids (Envelop-A)** will be opened in the Conference Room of the Head of Chancery, High Commission of India, Plot 1-3 Park Road, Baridhara, Dhaka-1212, Bangladesh.
- b. Technical Bids will be opened at **1500 hrs** on **19.09.2019** in presence of participating bidders or their representatives and the Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) constituted by the competent authority of the High Commission of India, Dhaka.
- c. After evaluation of the Technical Bids, the qualified bidders will be shortlisted.
- d. **Financial Bids (Envelope-B)** of shortlisted bidders only shall be opened on a subsequent date which will be intimated to them by email/fax.
- e. Financial Bids (unopened) of those bidders who will not qualify at Technical Evaluation stage will be returned to them.
- f. The date fixed for opening of bids, if subsequently declared as holiday by the Government, the revised date of schedule will be notified. However, in absence of such notification, the bids will be opened on next working date and the time will remain unchanged.
- g. A letter of authorization shall be submitted by the biddersqrepresentatives before opening of the bids.
- h. Absence of any bidders or their representatives shall not impair the legality of the opening procedures.
- i. The authorized representative of bidders, present at the time of opening of the bids shall be required to sign an attendance sheet as a proof of having attended the financial bid opening.

2. Implementation period / Timelines

The complete implementation must be carried within 1 month after the signing of contract.

3. Locations for the Supply and Commissioning

The material/equipments covered under this tender document are required to be supplied and installed as per the instruction of **High Commission of India**, **Plot 1-3**, **Park Road**, **Baridhara**, **Dhaka-1212**, **Bangladesh**.

4. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

The Bid shall be neatly arranged, plain and intelligible. Each page of the bid should be signed. They should not contain any terms and conditions, printed or otherwise, which are not applicable to the Bid. The conditional bid will be summarily rejected. Insertions, postscripts, additions and alterations shall not be recognized, unless confirmed by biddercs signature. The bidder, as part of its Technical bid, will submit its company profile and information regarding its key personnel, per **Annexure-6** of this tender document, with supporting documents such as copy of National ID, etc.

5. Late Bids

Any bid inadvertently received by HCI, Dhaka after the deadline for submission of bids, will not be accepted and returned unopened to the bidder.

6. Amendment of Bidding Documents

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, HCI, Dhaka may, for any reason, whether on its own initiative or in response to the clarification request by a prospective bidder, modify the bid document, but before opening of technical bids.

7. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- a. The tender documents must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of appropriate amount, in the form of a Demand Draft (DD) drawn on any Nationalized Bank, in favour of 'High Commission of India, Dhaka'. The amount towards EMD is Tk. 42,000/- [Taka Forty Two Thousand only] and should be submitted in the envelope containing technical bid. Bids submitted without EMD will stand rejected. EMD will not be accepted in the form of cash/cheque/ FDR/ BG or any other form except DD. No interest shall be payable on EMD.
- b. The EMD will be returned to the bidder(s) whose offer is not accepted by HCI, Dhaka within 30 days from the date of the placing of the final order(s) on the selected bidder(s).
- c. The successful bidder, on award of contract / order, must send the contract/ order acceptance in writing, within 7 days of award of contract/ order, failing which the EMD will be forfeited and the order will be placed to the next successful bidder.

d. The EMD shall be forfeited:

- i) If the bidder withdraws the bid during the period of bid validity specified in the tender.
- ii) In case a successful bidder, fails to furnish the Performance Bank Guarantee
- iii) If the bidder fails to furnish the acceptance in writing, within 7 days of award of contract/order.

8. Purchaser's Right to amend Scope of Work

If, for any unforeseen reasons, HCI is required to change the Scope of Supply, this change shall be acceptable to the bidder without change in the unit price quoted.

9. Interpretation of the clauses in the Tender Document / Contract Document

In case of any ambiguity/ dispute in the interpretation of any of the clauses in this Tender Document, HClos interpretation of the clauses shall be final and binding on all parties.

10. Cancellation of Tender

The High Commission reserves the right to cancel the tender or re-tender at any stage for security reasons or for any other reason as decided by the Competent Authority.

11. Notification of Award of Work

- (a) HCI, Dhaka shall award the work to the eligible bidder whose bid will be accepted and determined as the lowest evaluated commercial bid.
- (b) The lowest price criteria shall be applied on the total.
- (c) If more than one bidder happens to quote the same lowest price, HCl, Dhaka reserves the right to split the order and award the contract to more than one bidder.
- (d) Award of work will be notified as per pro- forma given in Annexure-3 to this tender document.

12. Contract Agreement:

- a. The successful bidder will be required to sign a Contract Agreement with the High Commission of India, Dhaka as per the format given in Annexure-4.
- b. The Contract Agreement must be signed within seven (7) days after the acceptance of the Notification of Award of Work by the successful bidder.

13. Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG):

The successful bidder will be required to furnish the Performance Bank Guarantee in form of a Bank Guarantee for the 10% (ten percent) amount of the Purchase Order, as per the format attached to this document (Annexure. 5). After submission of BG, EMD and other payment will be released. This bank guarantee shall remain valid till the completion of warranty period/defect liability period.

14. Warranty:

All the items covered under the schedule of requirements, shall carry a warranty as provided by the OEM firm of the said equipment or a minimum 1 (one) year on site comprehensive warranty from the date of Installation/Commissioning/completion. The bidder must undertake to provide the installation and warranty service at Dhaka. The repairing/ rectification/replacement/ configuration required, if any, of the items under warranty must be done at on site workshop.

15 Payments:

- a. 10% of the price quoted will be paid as mobilization advance to the contract awardees within one month from the date of issue of work order on submission of BG of an equivalent amount.
- 80% of the price will be paid on successful installation and commissioning of the equipments as per tender document and to the satisfaction of High Commission of India Dhaka.
- c. 10% of the price quoted will be kept as Retention money (to ensure quality construction as per tender specifications). It will be released on the completion of warranty period/defect liability period or against submission of Bank Guarantee of equivalent amount from any bank valid for the entire period of warranty/defect liability.

16. Penalty for delayed Services:

- a. HCI reserves the right to levy penalty @ of 0.5% of CIF value per day of delay beyond the scheduled deliveries/execution of the order successfully, subject to maximum of 5% of the order value.
- b. HCI reserves the right to cancel the order in case the delay is more than 8 weeks.
- c. The penalties, if any shall be recovered from the 20% claim due after installation/commissioning/completion.

17. Force Majeure:

HCI may consider relaxing the penalty and delivery requirements, as specified in this document, if and to the extent that, the delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an Force Majeure. Force Majeure is defined as an event of effect that cannot reasonably be anticipated such as acts of nature (like earthquakes, floods, storms etc.), acts of states, the direct and indirect consequences of wars (declared or undeclared), hostilities, national emergencies, civil commotion and strikes at successful Bidderos premises.
